

UC CAMPING POLICY FOR THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL AND SITE CLEANING

Alcohol

The consumption of alcohol by guests staying at UC Camping sites is not encouraged by Management or the Campsite Committee. The consumption of alcohol is generally prohibited, however, may be permitted in accordance with the following guidelines:

1. Consideration will be given to groups who make a written request for alcohol to be allowed.
2. A decision will be made by Management based on the nature of the group and function being held. Generally functions such as weddings, anniversaries, corporate conferences and milestone birthdays other than 21sts and 18ths will be considered.

Alcohol will generally not be permitted when:

- More than one group is using the facilities.
- When school or youth groups are involved.
- Management determines not to allow alcohol.

If alcohol is permitted the following conditions apply:

- Groups will supply their own alcohol.
- Groups must make their own arrangements for secure storage and cooling of drinks.
- UC Camping will not handle or serve any alcohol without prior arrangement and appropriate payment.
- UC Camping will not provide glassware other than standard camp supplies without prior arrangement and appropriate payment.
- Guests must remove all rubbish from buildings and ensure recyclable containers (cans bottles etc.) are put in the yellow recycle bins or the large co-mingle bins and general waste is deposited in the green bins.
- **Excessive use and / or intoxication will not be tolerated. This will lead to immediate termination of hire.**

Site cleaning

At the completion of hire it is expected that the site will be cleaned. The following cleaning will need to be completed prior to departure:

- All personal property removed from rooms.
- All rubbish placed in appropriate bins (recyclable containers in yellow bins or the large co-mingle bins and general waste in green bins). If rubbish needs to be separated by UC Camping staff the Alcohol and Cleaning Bond/ deposit will be forfeited.

- Absolutely no smoking in any buildings. All butts to be disposed of appropriately – smokers will need to provide their own receptacles. If UC Camping staff need to pick up cigarette butts the Alcohol and Cleaning Bond/ Deposit will be forfeited.
- If the group is self-catering then all food must be removed at the completion of the hire. Kitchen and dining areas are to be left in a clean and tidy state.

The Bond

An additional bond/ deposit of \$1,000.00 must be paid. This will be refunded at the conclusion of hire if all UC Camping regulations have been adhered to.

Management reserves the right to either allow or disallow alcohol on UC Camping property without favour or discrimination. The decision of Management will be final and no justification will be provided or deemed necessary.
